Invite everyone in your Family to play a game of leap Frog.	<b>9</b> /Ff/ is for Friend. Make an invitation to invite a Friend to play.
<b>10</b> National Library Week Make a card for your Favorite library staff member.	<b>11</b> Visit the library and deliver the card you made yesterday.	<b>12</b> Make a Fishing rod out of household items. (straw? popsicle stick? string? paper clips? Magnet? Use your imagination.)	<b>13</b> Visit a pet store, the zoo or aquarium and look at Fish tanks. How many different colors are the fish?	<b>14</b> Look at calendars to Find Friday. What is your Favorite day of the week? Why?	<b>15</b> The Titanic sank on this date in 1912. Talk about things that Float and sink! Experiment in the tub.	<b>16</b> /Ff/ is for Fly. Make a list of all the vehicles that can Fly! Draw pictures too!
<b>17</b> National Kite Month Go Fly a kite. (Or, sing the song "Let's Go Fly a Kite".)	<b>18</b> TELL your child the story of the Three Little Pigs. Use silly voices for the wolf and pigs. Now ask your child to tell YOU the story.	<b>19</b> /Ff/ is for Flowers. Go for a walk in search of Flowers. Draw a picture of what you Found.	<b>20</b> "Read" the letters of the Fast Food Restaurants you drive past today.	<b>21</b> Kindergarten Day Practice writing your name. (First and last. Only the first letter is capitalized.)	<b>22</b> Earth Day Be conservative today - Turn off unused lights and don't run unnecessary water.)	<b>23</b> /Ff/ is for Friend. Have a play date with a Friend.
<b>24</b> /Ff/ is for Fort. Build a Fort with blankets. Read a book inside.	<b>25</b> Sing a song and tap out the beat. (1-2-3-4-5 Once I count a Fish alive. 6-7-8-9-10 then I let him go again.)	<b>26</b> Happy Birthday John J. Audubon Count how many different birds you can watch outside today.	<b>27</b> Make a list of names that start with /Ff/. Sort them by boys and girls.	<b>28</b> Sing the alphabet Fast. Then sing the Alphabet slow.	<b>29</b> Arbor Day Draw pictures of trees. (Christmas, Apple and Maple for example.)	<b>30</b> Read any book with an /Ff/ in the title. Point to the title. Now Find the name of the author and the illustrator.
